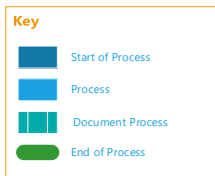
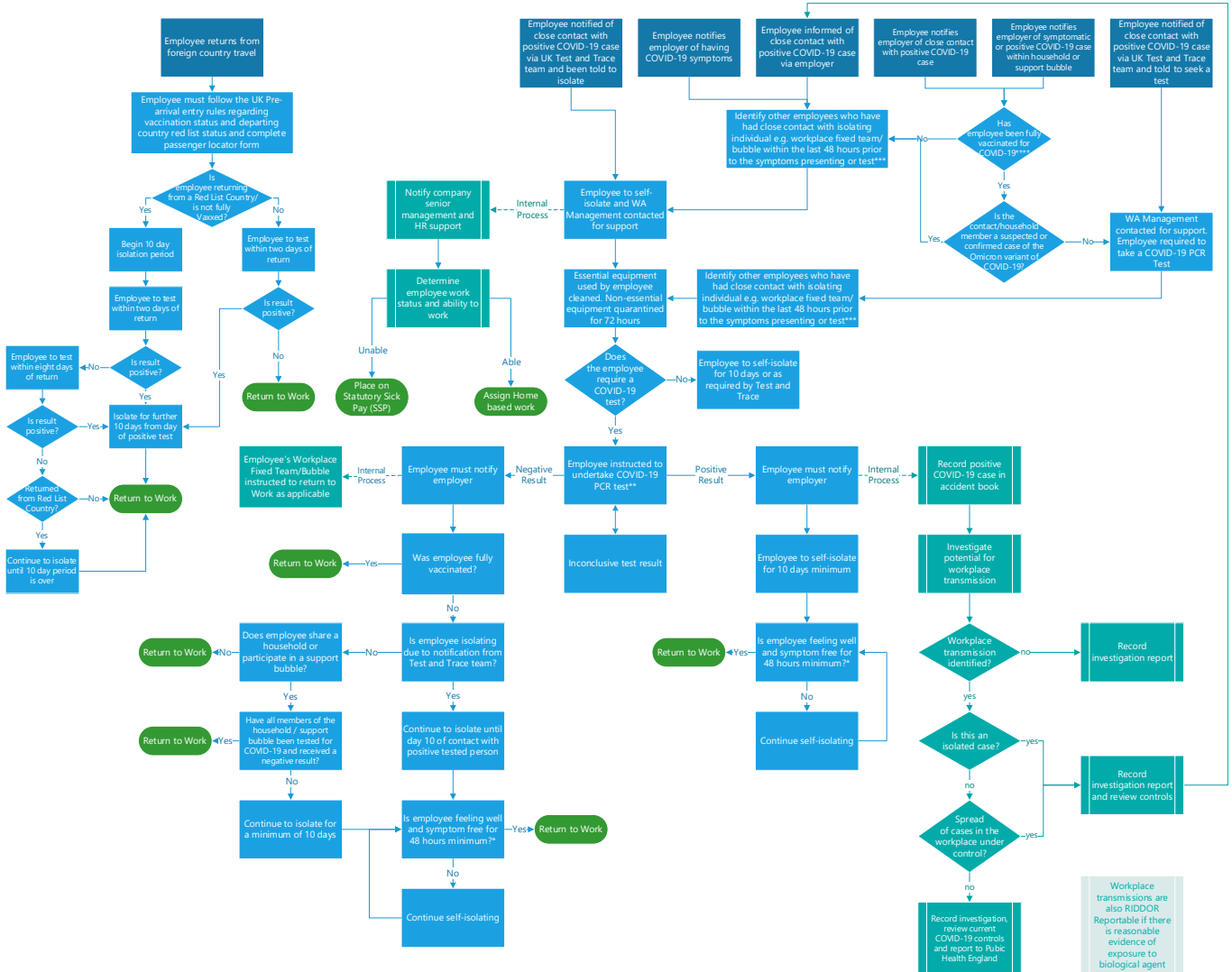


COVID-19 Incident Management Procedure



- * 48 hour period can include the last two days of isolation period
- ** If employee refuses COVID-19 test, they should continue to isolate for designated period.
- *** Fully Vaccinated means having received both jabs over 2 weeks ago
- Retain records of all locations employees visit during working hours for 21 days

*** Close contact is defined as:
 1. face-to-face contact including being coughed on or having a face-to-face conversations within one metre OR
 2. been within one metre for one minute or longer without face-to-face contact OR
 3. been within two metres of someone for more and 15 minutes (either as a one off contact, or added up together over one day)
 Self-isolation exemptions to persons under 16 years 6 months and persons who cannot be vaccinated for medical reasons are not valid when considering close contact with suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant of COVID-19.
